Executive Summary

Digital discovery has shifted from retrieval (blue links) to synthesis (AI answers). Traditional SEO is no longer sufficient. Marketers must optimize for **mention share** within the AI-generated answer itself.

1. Zero-Click Search and AI Overviews

58.5% of searches end without a click. When AI Overviews appear, it rises to 83%. Traditional search volume forecast to decline 25% by 2026. Live B2B SaaS audits reveal dense paragraphs and buried definitions are the primary citation barriers.

***The Fix:** Restructure content into semantic answer fragments — definition boxes, comparison tables, FAQ formats with FAQPage schema. This alone increases share of answer by 40%.*
